Nga mihi nui ki a koutou whānau, and a warm St Leo's blessing on you all

Spring is a time of renewal and hope, mirroring the spiritual rejuvenation that comes with the Resurrection of Christ at Easter. As nature awakens with vibrant flowers and fresh greenery, Catholics reflect on the promise of new life and the joy of the Resurrection, which signifies the triumph of life over death and sin. This season invites the faithful to embrace a spirit of renewal, both in their personal faith and in their commitment to living out Christ's teachings with renewed vigour and compassion.



We can help our tamariki to embrace a spirit of renewal in their personal faith and commitment to live out Christ's teachings through several meaningful practices. Maybe these practice will also reinforce our faith and commitment:

**Prayer and Reflection:** Encourage them to develop a habit of daily prayer, asking for guidance and strength to grow in their faith. Simple prayers of thanks and requests for help can foster a deeper connection with God.

**Acts of Kindness:** Teach to perform small acts of kindness and charity, whether helping a friend, sharing with siblings, or volunteering in their community. These actions reflect Christ's love and compassion.

**Learning and Sharing:** Engage in learning about Bible stories and the teachings of Jesus, and encourage them to share these lessons with others. This helps them understand and internalise the values of their faith.

**Participation in Sacraments:** Support in actively participating in the sacraments, such as attending Mass regularly, receiving the Eucharist, and preparing for Reconciliation. These practices help strengthen their spiritual life.

**Gratitude and Forgiveness:** Teach the importance of being grateful for their blessings and practising forgiveness. Modelling and discussing these virtues help them live out Christ's teachings in their everyday interactions.

## Sister Bernadette (Recount from St Patrick)

We loved having Sister Bernadette visit our school. She told us all about her life. It was hard for us to believe that she is 87 years old! Mrs Christy said Sister Bernadette is as sharp as a tac.

Sister Bernadette told us all about her family and the reasons she decided to become a nun. We learned that her father really wanted her to be a nun and her brother to be a priest. Because Sister Bernadette loved her father so much she decided to become a nun.

For her 70th birthday she climbed Mt Taranaki. Sister Bernadette was a school teacher and a principal. When she was a school teacher she had 68 children in her class, wow wow wow! We learned that you can have a career and be a nun all at the same time. Sister Bernadette told us about some of the careers nuns had, there were many who were teachers and nurses.

More recently, nuns have become lawyers and doctors. During Sister Bernadette's talk she showed us photos of her in her nuns uniform and photos of her family, she looked fabulous.

We cannot wait to see and hear from Sister Bernadette again.

*Sister Bernadette is from the Mission order of nuns which is a French order as opposed to the Sisters of Mercy who are Irish. She is 87 and has celebrated her platinum celebration as a Mission Nun. She is retired now and lives at The Murray Halberg Retirement Village in Hillsborough. She spent many years in Taranaki.*



## St Catherine News

Last week at St Catherine students finally got a chance to be part of the Garden to Table programme. They worked together to make kumara fritters. They absolutely loved it and had seconds and thirds.

They also had a visit from Sarah, Watercare educator. They learned about the differences between stormwater and wastewater, what causes overflows and what they can do to improve their local environment. By the end of the lesson they were able to understand that water runs downhill to the sea, appreciate that the shape of the hills and where they are placed affects where the rainwater travels, and understand what happens to water after it goes down a stormwater. They conducted experiments to prove their hypothesis.



## Te Wiki O Te Reo Maori

This week is Māori Language week and we started off the week with a visit from Ngahiwi and Terehia Walker. Ngahiwi carved a special taonga for the school. It tells the story of how our school is a part of Te Hau Kapua and how our values are an important part of our kura. At the centre is the cross of Jesus Christ who guides us in all the decisions we make. Please have a chat with your child and they can share what each part of the carving means.
