#### Whole School Mass

#### Teacher Only Day

The teachers worked alongside Viv Hall from Core Education to unpack the new NZ Histories Curriculum. It was a productive day where the teachers were able to make connections with the local history and charism of the school. This is an ongoing professional development that the teachers will undertake during the year.

St Clare led our assembly dramatising the Pentecost story. They showed us how the Holy Spirit helps us to spread the good news about Jesus. Assembly next week will be on Thursday at 12pm.

#### Matariki Celebration

Matariki celebrates people, culture, language, spirituality, history and respect for the environment. Respecting Mother Earth: Me aro ki te ha o papatuanuku" Matariki is a time to prepare the whenua on which we live. Matariki is an important constellation for the provision of kai as the whakatauki states, "Nga kai a Matariki nana i ao ake i runga"-Matariki scoops up the food. It is the start for all things new.

On Thursday the 23rd of June we will celebrate Matariki by gathering together as a school starting off with a whole school assembly at 12 pm. A sausage sizzle is being organised by the PTFA followed by traditional Maori games in the afternoon. We would also like the students to please bring either a **kumara** or a **potato** which will be roasted so that the students can share some kai together as a whanau. Please drop these at the office by 22nd June.



## **Lantern Making for Matariki Festival**

The Year 3-6 students made lanterns on Wednesday 15th of June. This initiative is tied to our Indigenous Ecology and Arts Wānanga and upcoming events around Puanga Matariki. In particular, we have a lantern hikoi (and connecting Peninsula hikoi through the green route earlier in the day) on Saturday, 25 June. Natanahira, parent volunteers and Wānanga volunteers helped the students learn the technique on a pyramidal lantern using patterning from Natanahira's carvings
