Jessie Tree

As you decorate your tree with these ornaments, you'll see how God planned and prepared for Jesus to be born by bringing together many generations of people. It's a fun and meaningful way to learn about the history and significance of Christmas!

The Jesse tree helps us connect the custom of decorating Christmas trees to the events leading to Jesus' birth. The Jesse tree is named from Isaiah 11:1: "A shoot shall come out of the stock of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots." Jesse was the father of King David.




After school music lessons at Belmont Int 2023
